

General Information

Registration:

The deadline for registration and abstract submission is August 20 (Thu.). Registration can be made through website (<http://usersmtn.nsrcc.org.tw/eng>) or e-mail (user@nsrcc.org.tw).

Abstract:

Research result is presented in poster form and one-page abstract in A4 format should be submitted in English. There is no limit on the number of abstract submission. For details, please download the sample abstract file available on the website (<http://usersmtn.nsrcc.org.tw/eng>).

Poster Session:

Poster boards are 100 cm (width) × 250 cm (height) in size. However, the size of poster is recommended to be 90 cm (width) × 120 cm (height). When posting, one should utilize a double-sided adhesive tape to attach the poster on the board. Tacks and magnets are forbidden. Each poster will be given a number and should be set up before 10:30 a.m. on Oct. 15. If your poster has been given a number and you are unable to put the poster on time, please contact User Administration Office beforehand (TEL: +886-3-578-0281 ext 7203 or 7205 or 7207 or 7213). Poster session will begin at noon of Oct. 15. It is required that the poster authors should be present on site. All posters should be removed by 5 p.m. on Oct. 16. Any posters left unattended will be discarded after the meeting.

Student Contest:

Students who wish to participate in the contest should download recommendation form from the website, have his/her supervisor sign the form, and return it via e-mail (user@nsrcc.org.tw) or fax (+886-3-579-0572) or by uploading it to the website. Please be reminded that the student contest process has been changed for this year. Contest participants must set up the posters before 10:30 a.m. on the first day of the meeting and are also required to prepare a 15 minutes English oral presentation in advance. The oral presenters will be selected and announced on the first day and shall give the oral presentations in the afternoon on the next day. The awarding ceremony will take place at the banquet on Oct. 16.

Language:

In the users' meeting, all reports (including oral presentation, poster, and abstract) should be presented in English. Please note that only Users' Town Meeting will be conducted in Chinese.

Meal & Accommodation:

Lunch will be served at the Poster Room on both days. Attendees of the Interest Group Meetings in the evening of Oct. 15 will be provided with dinner box at the meeting. For the banquet on Oct. 16, all attendees, except the invited speakers, the oral report presenters, the presenter of the poster presentation and his/her P.I., and the Users' Meeting's staff, will be charged NT\$200 and payment should be made at the registration desk during registration period.

Participants who intend to stay at the guesthouse of NSRRC should check "Housing" box in the registration form. Please provide your roommate's name on the form if you have chosen one. Those who are giving poster presentations will be given higher priority in the housing assignment. The remaining rooms shall be allocated on a first-registered-first-served basis.
